### The Heart of a Shepherd

Mark 8:29 "He said to them, 'But who do you say that I am?'"

The definition of a steward is "one who manages another's property, finances, or affairs."

If you claim to be a Christian, your life is all about being a steward of all that God has entrusted to you. In all aspects of our life, we are called to glorify Him who sent his Son to die for our sins. Take a moment and reflect upon your stewardship in the areas of seeking Him and serving Him. If you are struggling in those areas of your life, you are more than likely also struggling in the areas of family, finances, friends & fellowship.

Our stewardship in the above areas of our life is a direct reflection of our stewardship of the time we spend at the foot of the cross. If we would simply sit at His feet and learn of Him and from Him, the above areas of our lives would speak the answer to the question that Jesus posed to Peter in the above verse. **Mark** 8:29 "But who do you say that I am?"

The problem that we run into most of the time is our inability to see our lives clearly in the light of scripture. We manifest an image that appears to us to be Christ-like but in reality, it is simply a dim reflection of what we perceive Christ to be like. We at times lack the strength to persevere in all things, because we persevere in our own strength and with our own knowledge.

How we manage those areas of our lives that God has given us stewardship over reflects directly upon our love for Him.

Take a moment and reflect upon your relationship with your wife, your kids, your boss, your friends, those you work with and the list goes on and on. As you examine all the areas of your life that God has called you to be a steward of, are you? Ask yourself the question that Jesus asks of Peter, **Mark 8:29** "But who do you say that I am?" Does your stewardship in your life attest to the answer that Peter gives?

Mark 8:29 "Peter answered and said to Him, 'You are the Christ."
