The Beauty of the Lord

In her quiet time, In her moments of reflection, Elizabeth Barrett Browning's thoughts ran to the one she loved.

She thought about the depth and breadth of her love and began to write, "How do I love thee, let me count the ways." Her words express a deep and endless love. The words poured out through the ink of her pen and onto the paper as she recorded her thoughts.

And as I thought about her expression of love, I wondered to myself, how do I love you, my Lord? Can I even begin to express the ways? I can't even get my arms around your vast love for me. But I'm not alone, even David wrote in the 139th Psalm, "Such knowledge is to wonderful for me; it is high; I cannot attain it."

CS Lewis describes our desire for the Lord this way, "We do not want merely to see beauty, though, God knows, even that is bounty enough. We want something else which can hardly be put into words—to be united with the beauty we see, to pass into it, to receive it into ourselves, to bathe in it, to become part of it."

The beauty of the Lord is in no small part, the sanctification of the believer. So, you and I are the beautiful work of the Spirit of God.

Oh yes, I love you Lord with an undying love, and yet I know that you love me even more, and to think that all the Lord requires of me is told me in **Micah 6:8** "He has shown you, O man, what is good; And what does the LORD require of you. But to do justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God."

Simply said, if we are to express our love of the Lord, it might be wrapped up in two words, humble and kind. I believe we should always have an attitude that is humble and kind. In that way we express our love for Him and our kinship with Him. Deuteronomy 10:12 "Now, Israel, what does the Lord your God require from you, but to fear the Lord your God, to walk in all His ways and love Him, and to serve the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul."

Psalm 31:23 "O love the Lord, all you His godly ones!"
