### The Heart of a Shepherd

### Where was God?

This morning, as you read these words, it's been twenty years (25 years now) and a few hours since the world was shaken by the sight of an airliner striking the north tower of the world trade center. We had only begun to process what happened when seventeen minutes later another shock. United flight 175 was flown into the South tower building. As people were seen leaping to their death from the burning buildings, many were asking, how could this happen? Where was God?

Allow me to offer some thoughts for the one's asking, "where was God"? We may never know how many turned to Him in their final seconds of life and although there are many questions. The word of God does offer some answers. For the ones who had received Jesus Christ, whether years before this moment, or in the inferno, they each had a promise from God.

"I will never leave you nor forsake you" Hebrews 13:5. That may be hard for us to imagine in these moments, but again we are reminded that God promised to be with us through our journey whether in times of joy or through the valley of the shadow of death. As the psalmist wrote, "Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me" Psalm 23:4. For the believer, a moment of terror became an eternity of unspeakable joy. His holy word says, "He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness For His name's sake. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over" Psalm 23:3, 5.

Where was God on September 11, 2000? Just as He was 1980 years ago, with the thief on the cross, He was in the north tower at 8:46 am. And He was there in the South tower at 9:03 am.

Just a note: I received the following message on Facebook from a dear friend the very morning I began writing this devotion. It is a present-day illustration of God being ever present in His believers. It reads:

"Thank you, dear Jesus, for never leaving me. You were there through the darkest hours of my battle with Covid Pneumonia. Your word is sure, and your love is unfathomable. So many simple lessons learned in the darkness. Thank you for whispers of hope."
