GRN is a leading provider of Christian evangelistic and discipleship audio visual materials to the least reached language groups of the world. Their passion is to work where there are no translated Scriptures and no viable local church, or where a written Scripture or portion is available but where there are few if any who can read it or make sense of it.

Audio visual materials are a particularly powerful evangelism medium as they communicate the gospel in story format suitable for oral learners. GRN recordings can be downloaded free of charge from their website, and distributed via CD's, email, Bluetooth and other media. Since they began in 1939, they have produced recordings in around 6,500 languages. That's over 1 language per week! Many of these are the least reached language groups in the world.

The Deacon's Corner

Good Morning Oak's and Stone's family.

I was thinking one day about majestic Oak trees and the hillside behind my house that is covered in rocks and boulders (large rocks). Some will fit in the palm of your hand and others are boulders that are bigger than my house. Around the world these two things are a common visual that represent strength, power, permanence and often have breath taking beauty. When I stop to look at those rocks, small and large on the hillside behind my house I know that I am just looking at rocks.

A few years ago, I decided to collect a bunch of those rocks with my tractor. I gathered the biggest rocks my big tractor could pick up and I stacked them to build a retaining wall out of them. By doing this I gave these rocks a new definition. They now have a purpose and are now called Stones. Think about the last time you picked up a rock and when we skipped it across the water, it became a stone (skipping stone) That is because you gave it a purpose. Even though it will sink forever to the bottom, it will always be a skipping stone. Quite simply a stone is transformed from a rock. Next time you look at your granite counter tops just know that it is a stone, transformed from a rock.

So, does that mean that we were once rocks and now we are stones? Yes, I say. Jesus is our Rock of salvation from which we are made into precious stones. Jesus is the Cornerstone of our salvation and that Cornerstone is the foundation on which we stand.
