Women's Monday Morning Bible Study – 9-10 AM

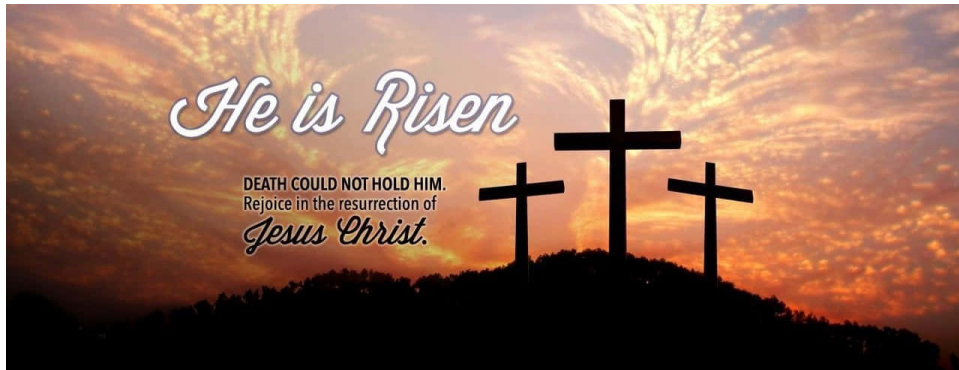
Our study is canceled this week. Hope to see everyone on April 13th.

The Heart of a Shepherd

"BEHOLD! THE LAMB OF GOD WHO TAKES AWAY THE SIN OF THE WORLD" John 1:29

Because all of us are sinners, a sacrifice had to be made on our behalf that we might see the Kingdom of God. **Hebrews 9:22** tells us that **"without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins"** and **Hebrews 9:26** says that **"He has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself."**

Jesus is the Lamb that was slain for our redemption. He was that perfect spotless lamb that was sacrificed for us. Because He was slain to put away sin, those who believe and trust in Him can have life, both abundant life now and eternal life with Him later. **John 1:12–13** **"But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: ¹³ who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God."**

Ephesians 2 makes it clear that there is nothing we can do to save ourselves, so let's stop trying to do that and just trust Christ, the Lamb of God, who was slain for us.

Ephesians 2:1–10 **"And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins, ² in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience, ³ among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others. ⁴ But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, ⁵ even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), ⁶ and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, ⁷ that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. ⁸ For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, ⁹ not of works, lest anyone should boast. ¹⁰ For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them."**

It is my prayer that no one leaves this morning without coming to know Jesus as their personal Lord and Savior.
