The Heart of a Shepherd

Psalm 107:23–24 *"Those who go down to the sea in ships, Who do business on great waters, ²⁴ They see the works of the Lord, And His wonders in the deep."*

The fact of the matter is that as Christians we are always immersed in oceans of opportunity to do business on great waters with our Lord.

Are you experiencing the waves of life this week? How large are the waves that our Lord and Savior has allowed to come upon you?

At times do you feel as if you are in a dingy amidst the storms of life? Ever wish that your dingy would turn into an enormous cruise ship that would be able to withstand the very storms that our Lord has allowed to come upon you?

We would do well to not think about the size of the storms of life that we are in but to focus on who is with us in the storms of life.

Psalm 107:28–32 *"Then they cry out to the Lord in their trouble, And He brings them out of their distresses. ²⁹ He calms the storm, So that its waves are still. ³⁰ Then they are glad because they are quiet; So He guides them to their desired haven. ³¹ Oh, that men would give thanks to the Lord for His goodness, And for His wonderful works to the children of men! ³² Let them exalt Him also in the assembly of the people, And praise Him in the company of the elders."*

Are you in a storm, this week? Seek shelter in the Lord and His peace that passes understanding will comfort you.

Psalm 46:1 *"God is our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble."*
