Happy Father's Day!

1 John 4:7–11 *"Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. ⁸ He who does not love does not know God, for God is love. ⁹ In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him. ¹⁰ In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. ¹¹ Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another."*

What a wonderful greeting, "**Happy Father's Day**", to hear on a day that has been set aside for the remembrance and the celebration of fathers.

I am blessed to have children, grandchildren and a great grandson who love me and honestly I am looking forward to hearing them tell me today that they love me. The great thing about my kids and grandkids is that it does not have to be Father's Day for me to hear or experience the phrase "I love you" from my family. They tell me & show me the true meaning of "Happy Father's Day" by the way that they treat me and love me, especially when it is not the "official" Father's Day.

How do we tell God our Father that we love Him? **Is it by our words? Yes. Psalm 19:14** *"Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart Be acceptable in Your sight, O Lord, my strength and my Redeemer."*

Is it by our deeds? Yes. Matthew 5:14–16 *"You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵ Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. ¹⁶ Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."*

Why should we tell our Father in heaven that we love Him? Ephesians 1:3 *"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ..."*

How can we tell our fathers that we love them? Tell them and show them who your Father in Heaven is. Have a wonderful Father's Day
