The Deacon's Corner

Acts 17:11 – "These were more fair-minded than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness, and searched the Scriptures daily to find out whether these things were so."

Good morning Church, when I walk into church and I don't have my Bible, I feel like a school kid that didn't bring my schoolbooks to the class. I believe bringing your bible to church is more than carrying a book! it's carrying God's living word into the place He has given us and where He desires to teach and transform us.

I believe when we are following along with the message with our Bible wide open, pen/highlighter, in hand, we are active listeners instead of passive hearers. We can read the verses for ourselves, take notes, and return to them throughout the week or even 34 years later.

The good Lord wants us to be wise and tells us examine the Scriptures to verify what we've heard so we're not led astray with false teachings. In doing this, our walk, our witness and our faith grows stronger when we know God's word personally. As for me, my bible in my hands helps me to stay engaged, compare Scripture with Scripture, and treasure God's truth in my heart and gives me the opportunity to make those highlights to things I'd like to go back to next week or 34 years later.

Whether your Bible is well-worn or brand new, (mine is 34 years new) bring it with expectation. Every page, chapter, verse was put there by God for us because it points us to God's faithfulness, wisdom, promises and love for us.

As you open our Holy Father's word in church, ask the Holy Spirit to help you understand it and apply it to your life.
